## SECTION 1. ECONOMICAL DEVELOPMENT AND STRATEGIES

#### IN OUR REGIONS AND ABROAD

- focusing on problems concerning the general field of economics and management, the European Integration of our countries, the differences between the development of the regions from Eastern Europe and the management of diminishing unfavorable differences, including aspects regarding the globalization and economy of small and medium enterprises, human resources, management strategies and organization behavior, provides a leading forum for interaction and research on the competitive strategies of managers and the organizational structure of firms;

#### SECTION 2. MEDICAL ISSUES, LABOR HEALTH AND VETERINARY MEDICINE

- Date: Thursday,  $\underline{23}^{rd}$  Friday,  $\underline{24}^{th}$  of April,  $\underline{2009}$ .
- The official language at the Symposium is **English**, and the papers will be accepted only in **English**.
- The Symposium is an open invitation for all specialists, professors, researchers and experts in all scientific fields, who can produce a free presentation of the results in their activities. There will be oral and poster presentations. For all registered participants, cold lunch will be served and a reception will be held on Thursday evening.
- The Symposium includes plenary sessions, work-shops, poster presentations, informative and agreement actions. The papers of a high scientific level will be presented during the Symposium, while the rest of the papers will have a poster-form presentation. Oral presentation: Invited speakers will have 20 min, and other participants 10 min (+ 5 min for discussion). Overhead and PC projectors will be provided. Should you need extra equipment, please, contact the organizers in due time. Poster presentation: The maximal width of posters is 90 cm, and the length, 140 cm. The boards are of hard wood, adhesive tape and pushpins will be provided.
- The papers will have to frame into topics, to have an interdisciplinary character, and to be at the level of an international symposium. The selected papers will have to be presented in the Symposium sections therefore the presence of one of the authors is required. It is preferable for the papers to have an interdisciplinary characteristic and to treat themes of mutual interest for our geographical area: eastern HUNGARY, northern SERBIA and western ROMANIA. Priority is given to papers produced by a mixed team of researchers from the three countries. Researchers from other countries may participate as well, on the condition of applicability for their results on the above mentioned geographical areas. The papers, classified according to the topics and presented in the Symposium sections, will be collected in the CD volume proceedings. Also, the selected papers will appear in a special number of the multidisciplinary engineering journal Annals of Faculty of Engineering Hunedoara - Journal of Engineering (Fascicule 4/2009, print version, ISSN 1584-2665).
- The Symposium fee for authors and participants is 60 Eur (the first paper) and 20 Eur (the second paper). The Symposium fee for members of Association for Multidisciplinary Research (ACM-V) is **40** Eur (the first paper) and **20** Eur (the second paper).
- The Symposium fee for authors and participants includes only Symposium expenses, the Volume of Proceedings, the accompanying materials, admission to all sections and presentations, and refreshments. The Registration Fee does not include accommodation (15 Eur/night) and meals (15 Eur/day). Normal Text, font type Georgia, size 10, Justify, 100...200 Words

#### ABOUT THE SCIENTIFIC PAPERS ...

The paper will be prepared with normal text, font type Georgia, size 11, Justify, single spacing, even number of pages (4-10), A4, with 25 mm margins. The paper must contain the following chapters:

1. INTRODUCTION

2. THE STUDY

3. ANALISES, DISCUSIONS, APPROACHES, INTERPRETĂTIONS

4. CONCLUSIONS

5. REFERENCES

ONLY PAPERS HANDED TO THE ORGANIZERS DURING THE CONFERENCE WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR PUBLICATION. The manuscripts should be prepared according to the instructions specified above.

- The final announcement of confirmation for publishing and the day of presentation will be sent by 30 March 2009.
